Step 4: Gather the following document(s) based on grade level:

PSEO Sophomores:

1. Official high school transcript showing GPA of 2.0 or greater
2. Copy of 8th grade Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment scores showing passing Reading score

PSEO Juniors & Seniors:

1. Official high school transcript showing both a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater AND a class rank in the top third (juniors) or top half (seniors)
2. *If your transcript does not show class rank*, you must also provide a nationally standardized, norm-referenced test (e.g. PLAN, ACT, PSAT, SAT) with a composite score at or above the 70th percentile (juniors) or the 50th percentile (seniors), OR a letter from your high school counselor verifying you are in the top third (juniors) or top half (seniors) of your graduating class.

Step 5: Attach this checklist to the documents from Steps 3 & 4, and submit them before the PSEO application deadline to:
