

Over \$298,335 in scholarships were awarded to students across the College.


Students received over \$300,000 in emergency aid grants to support wrap-around services and basic needs, helping them overcome unexpected expenses like car repairs, utility bills, food, and childcare, ensuring they persist and thrive in their studies.

The endowment grew to \$3,200,308 during the 2023-2024 school year. Funds are held at the Saint Paul & Minnesota Foundation.



2024 REVENUE


